L&CPU PROJECTED DIGITAL IMAGE CLUB CHALLENGE

Rules of Entry 2010

1. At least one representative of each participating club is expected to be present, or other persons appointed by that club who will co-ordinate their entry in Round Two, or the Final.
2. In the first round each club will enter 8 Images, 1 Image from each Club will be shown sequentially until all images have been projected.
In the second round each club will enter 8 different images, 1 image from each club will be shown sequentially until all images have been projected.
The total scores from rounds one and two will be added together and the top eight clubs will proceed to the final.
The eight clubs contesting the final will submit 20 images of which 10 may have been entered in previous rounds. 1 image from each club will be shown sequentially until all images have been projected.
3. All work entered must be original in concept, and the copyright of such work must be at the disposal of the entrant.
4. No author may be represented by more than 2 images in Rounds One and Two, and 4 images in the Final.
5. No club may enter more than 2 Nature Images in Rounds One and Two, and 4 Nature Images in the Final
6. Images shown in previous PAGB Slide Championships are ineligible. Images shown in previous L&CPU Slide Championships are eligible, provided that they have not been used in the PAGB event.
7. Each club may select its images for each round from a bank of a maximum of 40.

- The completed title sheet for the first round images.
- The list of the bank of images to be selected from. (up to 40)
- All the images.

8. Any club failing to provide its entry with completed title sheet at the start of any round will be deemed to have forfeited that round.
9. In the case of a tie in the final round between the clubs, each club will be asked to submit a further 5 images for judging. These must not have been used in the preceding rounds; only 1 may be Nature, and not more than 1 image from any one author.
10. Image files must be correctly numbered using **Club Code sequential No. and title. (ie; A01_01_title.)**
11. Digital Image file size must be 1400 x 1050 pixels. Jpeg. sRGB.
If the image is less than the maximum in any direction (1400 wide 1050 high) the unused area should be filled with black or dark grey.
12. Photographers may only support one nominated club of which they must be *bona fide* members.
13. In any dispute or interpretation of the rules the decision of the L&CPU Competition Secretary will be final
14. The L&CPU reserve the right to allow reproduction without fee of any image in connection with the event.
15. For the day you will require a computer with your bank of 40 images on.
