### L&CPU INTER CLUB PRINT CHALLENGE

#### RULES OF ENTRY 2010

1. Each Club participating must have at least one representative present at the event.
2. Each Club to enter **12 prints in Round One** and, if eligible, **15 prints in the Final**. Round One prints may be replaced in the Final by new entries. Prints shown in previous PAGB Print Championships are ineligible. Prints shown in previous L&CPU Print Championships are eligible, provided that they have not been used in the PAGB event.
3. In both Round One and the Final each Club must submit at least 5 Monochrome and 5 Colour prints and not more than 3 Nature prints. The prints must come from a minimum of 5 different authors in both Round One and the Final and no author may enter more than 4 prints in either.
4. Summary;-  
**AT LEAST 5 MONOCHROME**  
**AT LEAST 5 COLOUR**  
**NOT MORE THAN 3 NATURE**  
**NOT MORE THAN 4 PER AUTHOR**  
**AT LEAST 5 AUTHORS**
5. Entries will be mixed and three judges will each "silent" score each print in the range 2 to 5.
6. The 8 Clubs with the highest aggregate score in Round One will contest the Final. (Clubs tying for 8<sup>th</sup> place will all contest the final).
7. The maximum mount size is 50 X 40 cm. Any Velcro and loose sticky labels must be removed or the print will be excluded.
8. Prints may be chosen from an unlimited "bank".
9. The Acorn Trophy will be presented to the Club achieving the highest aggregate score in the final
10. In the event of a tie, the judges will be shown the 15 prints from each tied Club and will choose a winner.
11. All work entered must be original in concept and the copyright must be at the disposal of the entrant.
12. General L&CPU rules concerning digital & monochrome will apply.
13. Photographers may only support one nominated club of which they must be bona fide members.
14. The L&CPU cannot accept any responsibility for loss of or damage to any photograph and reserves the right to allow reproduction without fee of any photograph in connection with the event.
15. In any dispute the decision of the L&CPU will be final. In any interpretation of the rules the decision of the Competition Secretary will be final.
