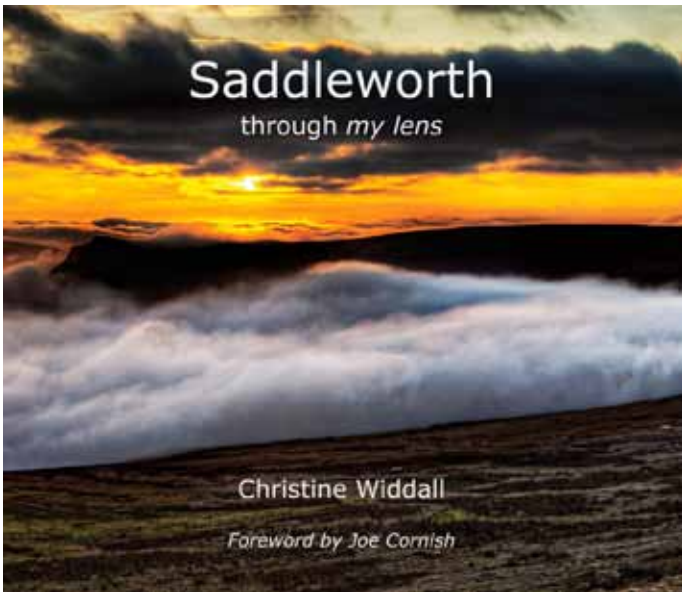


Saddleshworth
