An exhibition of photographs, put together by members of Macclesfield Camera Club and held as part of the Macclesfield Barnaby Arts Festival, June 2011 (<http://www.barnabyfestival.org.uk/>).

Short description - An exhibition of B&W photographs showing the people of Macclesfield, with examples covering the past 150 years, including a fine set of contemporary images

Long description - Despite the dramatic changes in Macclesfield over the past 150 years, the daily lives of its people remains the same: a trip to the shops, bank or pub, with kids still congregating in town once school has finished. This exhibition attempts to define that timelessness through a series of B&W photographic images of its inhabitants taken over 6 generations, including a fine set of contemporary images.
