



Latest News from Awards For All

Are you a community group? Would you benefit from lottery funding?

Grants of £500 - £5,000 are still available for community projects across the North West region under the **Awards for All** programme and applications are being encouraged.

Awards for All is actively encouraging Schools, health bodies, local groups, and parish or town councils with projects that support education, sport, the arts, heritage, health and the environment in their community to apply for funding under this scheme.

Money is now available through a straightforward application process. You will be advised within eight weeks if you have been successful and information is available to groups that are unsure about eligibility or how to apply.

Don't wait until the launch of the new £10,000 programme in April 2006, as there is likely to be increased competition and it is expected most of the awards will still be under £5,000.

Applying for a grant now will not prohibit you from applying again after April 2006, and groups are being encouraged to apply now, as demand for single grants for near the new £10,000 threshold may well be high. The combined amount of all grants held by the group must not exceed £10,000 in any 2-year period.
